

### **Featured Art Museum**

## Los Angeles County Art Museum (LACAM)

The Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) is an art museum located on Wilshire Boulevard in the Miracle Mile vicinity of Los Angeles. LACMA is on Museum Row, adjacent to the La Brea Tar Pits (George C. Page Museum).

LACMA was founded in 1961, splitting from the Los Angeles Museum of History, Science and Art. Four years later, it moved to the Wilshire Boulevard complex designed by William Pereira. The museum's wealth and collections grew in the 1980s, and it added several buildings beginning in that decade and continuing in subsequent decades.

LACMA is the <u>largest</u> art museum in the western United States. It attracts nearly a million visitors annually. It holds more than 150,000 works spanning the history of art from

# **Featured Non-SVA Artist**

### Paul Jackson Pollock

**Paul Jackson Pollock** (/'pplək/; January 28, 1912 – August 11, 1956) was an American painter. A major figure in the abstract expressionist movement, Pollock was widely noticed for his "drip technique" of pouring or splashing liquid household paint onto a horizontal surface, enabling him to view and paint his

canvases from all angles. It was called all-over painting and action painting, since he covered the entire canvas and used the force of his whole body to paint, often in a frenetic dancing style. This extreme form of abstraction divided the critics: some praised the immediacy of the creation, while others derided the random

effects. In 2016, Pollock's painting titled *Number 17A* was reported to have fetched US\$200 million in a private purchase.

A reclusive and volatile personality, Pollock struggled with alcoholism for most of his life. In 1945, he married the artist Lee Krasner, who became an important influence on his career and on his legacy. Pollock

died at the age of 44 in an alcohol-related single-car collision when he was driving. In December 1956, four months after his death, Pollock was given a memorial retrospective exhibition at the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York City. A larger, more comprehensive exhibition of his work was held there in 1967. In 1998 and 1999, his work was honored with large-scale retrospective exhibitions at MoMA and at the Tate in London. Kathleen Preininger-Johns is a renowned artist in the ethnic art of Pysanky. As owner of Oval Art, she has created hundreds of designed eggs for art galleries and collectors across the country. Over the past 30 years Kathleen has taught the 2,000 year old folk art through schools and art workshops, exhibited in juried art shows nationally and won awards for her one-of-a-kind pieces of artwork. She has donated eggs to several charitable organizations and has two goose eggs designs in the White House permanent collection. She is dedicated to keeping the art of Pysanky alive through her workshops and demonstrations.


